



Requirements for breeders (Appendix C)

1. In order to apply for breeder status, a member must be required to own at least one SABBA registered Boerboel bitch.
2. In order to register as a breeder, the member must apply to SABBA for the allocation of a stud name – three suggested names must be provided on the Membership Application form.
3. Once a breeder has registered with SABBA, a book of Birth Notification forms may be purchased.
4. Should a breeder make use of a Boerboel male (or the semen of a Boerboel) that does not belong to the breeder, said breeder must ensure that a Service Certificate accompanies the Birth Notification forwarded to the SABBA office (see Appendix D).
5. Breeders must ensure that the Birth Notifications are completed correctly and in full. The inclusion of the ID numbers of the parents is compulsory.
6. When a breeder sells a Boerboel puppy that, according to him/her, does not meet the Breed Standard requirements, *no* Birth Notification is issued.
