



Board members: Code of conduct and duties (Appendix K)

It is expected of Board members to:

1. strive and act to further the Mission, Vision and Constitution of SABBA at all times;
2. attend Board meetings as specified by the Constitution;
3. organise appraisal venues in the various provinces and regions as specified by Appendices to the Constitution F and G, with specific reference to the presentation of appraisal days;
4. appoint regional representatives to assist with the organisation of appraisal days;
5. identify and train administrative staff for the appraisal days;
6. promote and publicise the Boerboel in the various provinces and regions;
7. handle enquiries and resolve complaints;
8. identify apprentice appraisers;
9. respect SABBA structures and make a contribution to the Sub-Committees;
10. make SABBA the top priority in all dealings and conduct;
11. derive no commercial benefit as a result of having Board member status; and
12. strive for unity at all times and a compassionate outlook.
